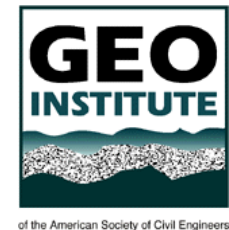
Geologic Issues Concerning

**Abstract**
